- 2. Welcoming Committee: may be a stand alone committee now, not under Discipleship (more discussion about this at the March meeting when we talk about the committees' organizational structure); April 22 New Member dinner (Renards catering), about 40 new parish members will be invited, new member sign up will now be during the 2nd weekend of the month vs. the first weekend (too many conflicts with first weekends); overall change–2 dinners per year and 2 coffee donut Sundays per year
- 3. Worship Committee: May=rosary before every weekend Mass and the third weekend; need volunteers (maybe new members)--a script can be provided; sign up in the back of church (we should note that a script could be provided with the sign up)
- 4. Discipleship: 3 Lenten retreats coming up
- 5. Auction coming up: a lot of donations:) At Eddie Whipps this year
- 6. Building project prayer | shortened version confirmed; start using this at the architect meetings | replace One by One Campaign prayer in the missalette
