Deacon Jeff's Corner



Last Sunday afternoon, we celebrated our First Communion Mass with 19 of our young people who received Jesus within them for the first time. As beautiful as the Mass was, as wonderfully our first Communicants and their families were dressed, as joyous as this occasion was, there is a great need to keep these youngsters and their families in your prayers. Realizing there are many needs we pray for – some daily – I am hopeful you can include them. Why? Let me explain.

For this past school year, our second graders were taught by our superb catechists, who voluntarily give their hearts and souls to help them prepare for the Sacrament of the Eucharist. They learned more and more that Jesus is really present in the form of a little piece of bread. They learned Jesus loves them so much that when they come to him in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, he forgives them of all their sins. They received that Sacrament of forgiveness for the first time this year as well.

Thus, I ask anyone who takes the time to read this, to pray for our First Communicants and their families, that they will keep Jesus in their lives, at home and here at the Mass. Also, that worldly temptations do not outweigh the incredible gift that Jesus offers us every time we attend Mass. I believe with all my heart the best way to make this happen is to pray for them. May we storm the heavens with our prayers on a daily basis, and watch how God grants our request by seeing all of them here on Sundays!

Dear Believers in Christ,

I am overwhelmed by our readings this weekend. The Church names this Sunday "World Day of Prayer for Vocations" because Jesus calls himself the "Good Shepherd."

The first questions: Is Jesus the Good Shepherd in my life? He describes himself this way. But is He to you? St. Paul writes, "See what love the Father has bestowed on us that we may be called children of God." I would invite you to make a list of the deeds of love that our Lord Jesus and the Holy Spirit do for you every day. What goodness, charity, cooperation in doing works that you cannot do yourself are done with the aid of the Lord? What relationships in your life are life-giving because of their presence?

We can truly thank the Lord for all of the relationships we have, all the opportunities which come our way and challenges that bring growth and new insight about yourself, your relationships and the world around you. This attitude of knowing Jesus and recognizing every spiritual and material opportunities come from him forms within us preparation for heaven.

The word around us is described by St. Paul in the second reading. He writes, "The reason the world does not know us is that it (the world) did not know him." Many people's reasons for doing what they perform are based on a desire to better themselves according to worldly standards and priorities. God and his ways are not sought after because their values and reasons for doing selfish goals would need to be changed. To follow Christ and his Church demands that we work at bringing Jesus and the Church's teachings into our mind, hopes and actions. Our world's ways are not joined to heaven. Only Christ's are. Pray that your vocation as single, family member or couple may be one with Christ.
