

very happy where we are today."

Faith and family come above everything else for the Fameree family. They attend Mass on the weekend, pray together at mealtime, and talk about faith in their home. Katie and Chad have been members of Prince of Peace Parish since 2005, and they appreciate belonging to a family-oriented community built around faith, family and fellowship. Chad also volunteers at the Prince of Peace Church Picnic and Paul's Pantry. Plus, he's a platelet donor for the American Red Cross.

The family enjoys skiing in the winter, boating in the summer, and going to the family cottage in Door County.

Katie is employed by the Denmark Public School District, and Chad works at Green Bay Country Club. The kids are busy with school and a variety of sports and extracurricular activities. Aubrey runs cross country and track and is active in FFA. Callen plays basketball, baseball, and football, and Vivian participates in basketball and dance classes.

"We spend a lot of time watching and cheering on our children," Chad said. "While we always encourage them, it's important that they understand to stay humble, be a good teammate, and work hard."

The Fameree family's favorite Scripture verse is Psalm 46:10: Be still and know that I am God.

"This is an important scripture for us because it shows us to trust in God's plan and be present in the moment," Chad said. Sometimes, putting trust in God doesn't come easily, but the Fameree family finds great comfort knowing that God has a beautiful plan for them, even in times of uncertainty.
