

We also now will thank him for his contributions to this wonderful parish as he prepares for the next chapter of his priesthood and life.





#### A Reflection on Today's Readings

I've never been in the Path of Totality. But my daughter, Elizabeth, experienced the last total eclipse while living in Nashville. Even though it was seven vears ago, she can describe the moment in detail: clear skies giving way to darkness, dropping temperatures. illuminated street lights, and chirping crickets. Despite all the information she had ahead of time, Elizabeth was caught off-guard. Nothing could have prepared her for the experience. It was eerie and amazing. It "took her breath away." She stood there with others chattering excitedly as they looked into the sky.

It makes me wonder how the individuals in today's post-resurrection account might have described their experience when Jesus appeared to them. As Luke tells us, two disciples who recognize Jesus in an earlier encounter are sharing their experience when Jesus comes into their midst. Luke uses words like "startled," "terrified," "incredulous," and "amazed," to describe the crowd's reaction.

Despite Jesus' instruction to them before his death, those assembled are caught off-guard. They didn't have the understanding that could have prepared them for this encounter with the Risen Christ. Jesus opens their minds to an understanding of the Scriptures; that he would suffer, die, and rise on the third day. He concludes the teaching with the words, "You are witnesses to these things."

We are witnesses to many things – including great celestial events. While our experiences are different than those of the men and women to whom he appeared, Jesus assures us that he is in our midst today in both the ordinary and extraordinary moments in our lives. Given that assurance, how might you describe your experiences with the Risen Christ?
