## Deacon Jeff's Corner

For the past few weeks, I have had the privilege of interviewing almost all of our Confirmation candidates in order to spend a little time with each of them. Basically, I ask them questions on why they would like to be confirmed, what they might expect from the Sacrament of Confirmation, and questions about their school, extracurriculars and plans for the future.

The conversations have been entertaining and informative for me and hope each student knows how much I care about them and their faith journey with Jesus. If there is one question I was particularly curious about the answers was the question on how many Sacraments there are in the Catholic Church. The answers ranged from 4 to as many as 54. In case you are wondering, there are seven sacraments in the Church: Baptism, Eucharist, Reconciliation, Confirmation, Anointing of the Sick, Marriage and Holy Orders. I'm not trying to be critical at all, as I care deeply for each of these young people. However, I do think this is something we all should know as a part of being a Catholic.

If there is a recommendation I would like to make for every household, it would be this: Please get a copy of *The Catechism of the Catholic Church*. It will cost \$10 but will be a valuable resource for any question you or anyone in your household may have. It is not intended to be read from beginning to end, but rather to look up any particular topic you desire. For example, "Sacraments" are listed in paragraph 1113. An explanation of each of the sacraments follows and is explained pretty simply.

Let's all try to learn a little more about our rich Catholic faith weekly by having a copy of *The Catechism* available in every home. I think you might just enjoy it!

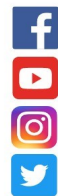

### FAQ'S:

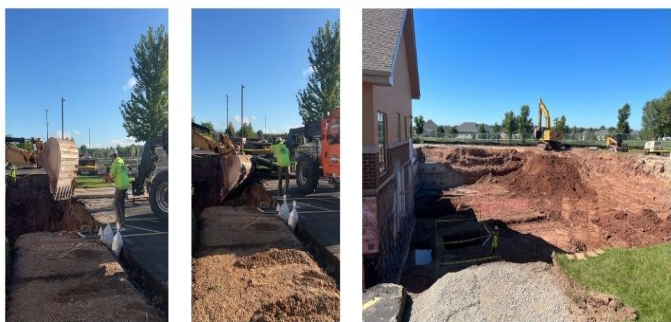
**Q: It looks like we lost parking space, is that true?**

### LOVE

Jerry Berg

*The three readings all revolve around one common theme, love. Seems simple enough to love your neighbor. However, we start out with a real challenge in the first reading, helping your neighbor correct their problems. Parents all love their children when they are growing up, but that carries with it a responsibility to correct their mistakes. Yet, when we expand that responsibility to adults, our neighbors or grown children, that responsibility becomes much more of a challenge.*

I've heard the story over and over about children that have left the church when they have grown up. We are still called to "warn them" for God. This doesn't need to result in a family conflict. Setting an example by the way we live our faith sends a message to them. St. Francis has been quoted as saying, "preach the Gospel and if you must, use words."

While the Gospel presents a continuation of this theme, it brings with it a call for prayer. That is the next step for us. If we have fulfilled the responsibility to warn our neighbor or children, it is not a time to walk away from helping them. It is a time for prayer, asking God for His help with the matter. While the reading today says that our prayers "shall be granted" it does not set a time frame, nor a method by which they will be answered. We simply need to trust in God and continue to pray.

In another of Paul's letters he says:

*"We urge you, brothers, admonish the idle, cheer the fainthearted, support the weak, be patient with all. See that no one returns evil for evil; rather, always seek what is good [both] for each other and for all. Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing." 1 Thess 5:14-17*

This church...you people...you kind and caring group...have given SO MUCH to begin our year with a full pantry of amazing merchandise to help those that NEED it and appreciate it.

Come on followers of Christ, why do you keep helping us? Why are you so stubborn to the facts of a world that tells us that maybe they should figure it out themselves?

And then...We needed HELP to get the Hive up and running because of a bit of mishap...And YOU helped. You came to clean, organize, fix, tidy, hope, pray, and support us.

What is wrong with you?!

Because of you, we are ready to help **a lot** of students that NEED help. They will get all of this for FREE; they will not be required to thank you, but they will live better, be happier, learn more and succeed in this world a bit easier.

So...we are not sure when you are going to understand that this world is supposed to be broken. That people that need the Grace of God and the love of a neighbor are supposed to somehow wither.

Until you do...Please know that **we are so grateful for you**. We are so blessed to be wrapped in your arms. We are fortunate to receive your prayers, your love, and your commitment to charity.
