Deacon Jeff's Corner

Following my corner last week on Mass intentions, we have received questions asking why we have been directed to have only one Mass intention at every Mass. Get ready for a bit of Ecclesial (Church) history!

This goes back to the 1500's, which was the time of the Protestant Reformation, initiated by Martin Luther. Luther objected to several things in the Church back then, called The 95 Theses. This is not the time nor the space to discuss that topic, but one of the issues going on at that time is that priests would accept many Mass intentions – as many as 20-30 for each Mass, and the argument was that priests were getting wealthy simply from Mass intention income.

The Council of Trent (1570), the Catholic response to the Protestant Reformation stated clearly that only one intention per Mass would be allowed. In addition, one Mass every weekend would be a "Pro Populo" Mass – a Mass for the people (Mass intention for the parish). Since then, Mass intentions have slowly increased; two or even more per Mass. Some parishes in our Diocese have up to five Mass intentions, clearly a violation of the Council of Trent. The Diocese instructed us to have only one intention per Mass, but now we are filled nine months out on our weekend Masses. Knowing how disappointed many of you are, we appealed to the Diocese and were given a bit of a reprieve.

We will now have two intentions for two weekend Masses, but the \$20 stipend paid for these Masses will go to the Leo Benevolent Fund – a retirement fund for our diocesan priests. Thus, we are not allowing these intentions to generate more revenue for the parish, but rather just to address the challenge we currently have that does not affect most of our diocesan parishes. I hope this helps to clarify this issue a bit. If you do have questions, please direct them to me, and I will be happy to discuss them with you!

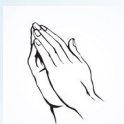

"HE IS HERE"

Today's 1st reading provides insight into how we should approach the teachings of Scripture... "all the people listened attentively to the book of the law." Just how attentive are we to the readings at Mass? For me there is a difference between hearing something read to me and engaging in what was read. That takes some effort on my part to internalize the Scripture readings. Maybe it is time to up our game and hear what God is saying to us personally.

The second reading is one of my favorites, we are all one body and called to share the gifts we were given. Our parish is really gifted with many people sharing their time and talent to build a vibrant and strong community. We may all want to reexamine our talents and ask if we are using them for Christ's calling. Many of us have time commitments or physical limitations that impede us from taking on more activities, but we are all able to pray and that may be the best way for us to share our gifts with the parish.

Luke's Gospel tells about the beginning of Jesus' adult ministry, returning to Nazareth where he had grown up. I like to imagine myself in the crowd as Jesus reads from the scroll. Would I ask myself: Did I really hear him say that he was the one Isaiah was talking about? Is he saying that he is the messiah? Do I trust him? This reading stops short and we don't hear that the community didn't believe him and rejected him. Do we recognize Jesus at work today in our community? Do we see Jesus in the people standing alongside of us? After all, we are all one body in Christ.

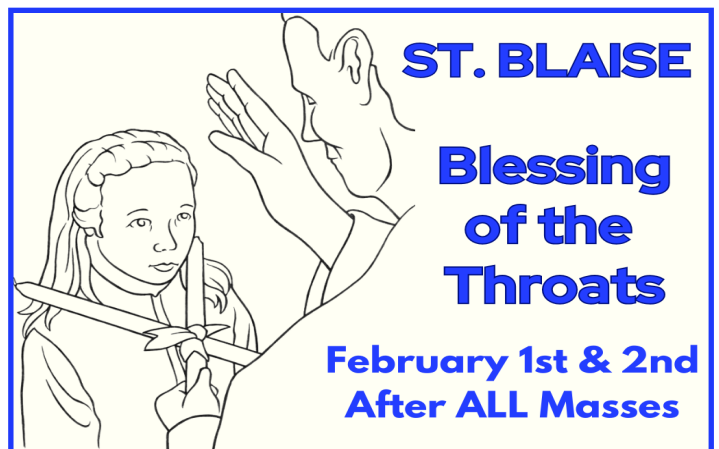
