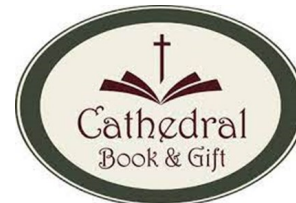

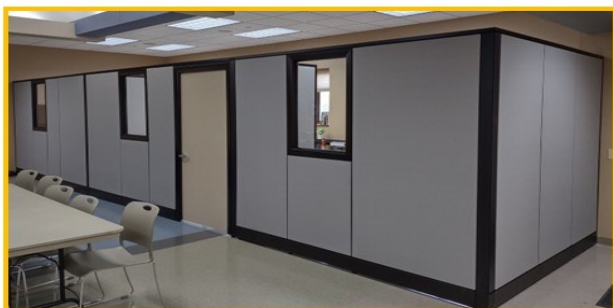

"Respect"

Fr. Bill Hoffman

This Sunday in October has been titled: "Respect Life Sunday"; our Scripture readings for this Sunday, and for every Sunday, and for every day of the year, call us to respect:

* God and all of God's creation.

A particular theme in our readings for this Sunday speak to respect for the institution of Marriage; the mutual respect between husband and wife, and the respect of all society for the very institution of Marriage.

What a challenge for Catholics in today's society where the definition of marriage has been redefined ... not to mention the confusion of some as to gender ... "male and female He created them.." Man and woman. The author of Genesis expresses two profound ideas: Woman compliments man, a social being by nature, but she is not a mere service appendage ... she "corresponds to him" = she has a similar nature. Isn't it interesting that "Man" names the animals (they are under his control) but God names "Woman".

In our reading from the Gospel of Mark, Jesus quotes Genesis as the reason why marriage is indissoluble ... and claims to voice God's will as against even Moses' authority.

Our Gospel also calls for a "respect" for the kids, the children. Some scripture scholars see Jesus' desire to have children come to him as an anticipatory approval of infant baptism ..the new beginning of life occurs in baptism.

Our "new life" in Christ calls from us a profound respect for all of God's creation ...for every person ... old and young and in-between...for the institution of marriage... that all the sons and daughters of God are "Pro - Life"!

Perhaps we could carry with us this week the beautiful Psalm response: "May the Lord bless us all the days of our lives" ... "Blessed are you who fear the Lord" ...your wife...your husband ...your children... "May you see your children's children..". Blessed are we who respect life.

Thank you for choosing the Direct Payment method. Your contributions will be deducted automatically from your checking or savings account. And, you won't have to change your present banking relationship to take advantage of this service.

The Direct Payment Plan will help you in several ways:

- It saves time – fewer checks to write.
- Helps meet your commitment in a convenient and timely manner – even if you're on vacation or out of town.
- It saves postage.
- It's easy to sign up for, easy to change.

Here's how the Direct Payment Plan works:

You authorize regularly scheduled payments to be made from your checking or savings account. Then, just sit back and relax. Your contribution will be made automatically on the specified day. And proof of payment will appear with your statement.

The authority you give to charge your account will remain in effect until you notify us in writing to terminate the authorization. If you would like to change the amount of your contribution you must notify us at least 10 days before the payment date.
