2. Coffee & Rolls Sundays – Ken & Joann M., Janet L.

 - i. About the same as last year
- d. Approximately 65 shoppers – down from last year.
- e. Santa was a big hit with the children that came to see him.
- f. We had 20 To-Go-Boxes left over to sell after Mass.
- g. Total profits approximately \$1,100, Scrip sold about \$200
