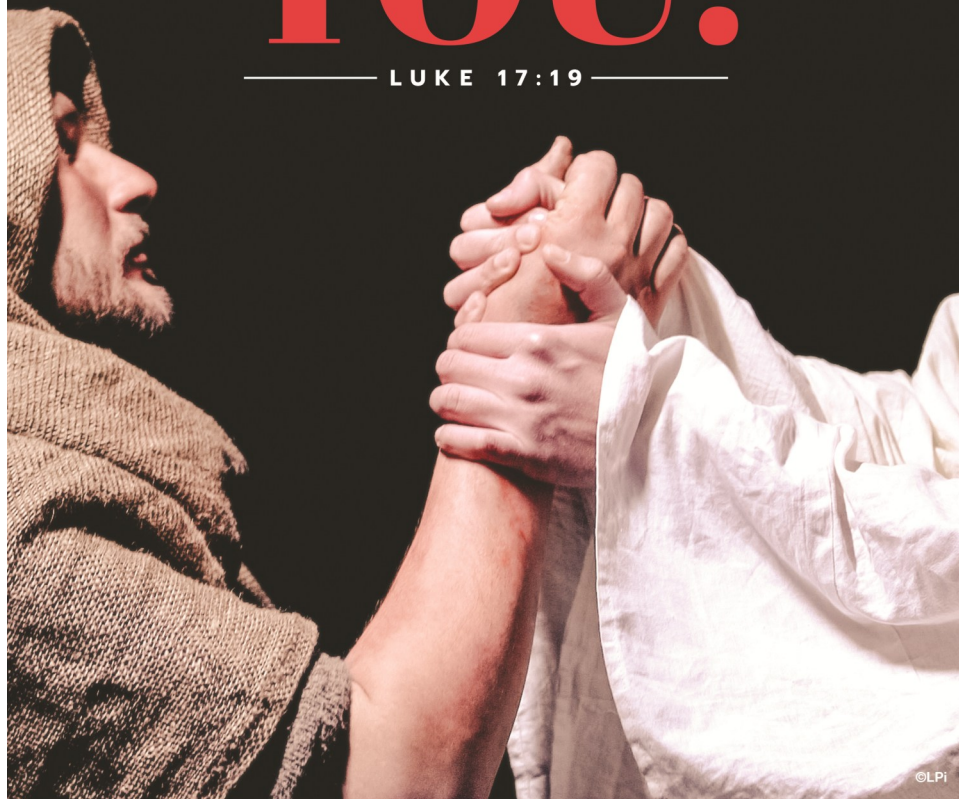

Deacon Jeff's Corner

Do you pray before you go to sleep at night? Too tired to pray? Don't know what to say? I suggest these questions, because they are the same questions/reflections I had for years. Prayer is always a choice. One of the many great things about our faith is that we have prayers we don't need to create or make up; there are many prayers to help us as we retire for the day.

One prayer I hear many people say they pray as they go to sleep is the Rosary. Since the Rosary takes 15-20 minutes, it can be a source of help to get to sleep and falling asleep with the Virgin Mary's help is certainly not the worst idea!

A prayer we pray as a staff during our weekly prayer time is a short, but powerful prayer called the Anima Christi. Translated from Latin, Anima Christi means, "Soul of Christ". This a great prayer to say after receiving Jesus in the Eucharist, but I find it comforting as I prepare to go to sleep.

*Soul of Christ, sanctify me. Body of Christ, save me. Blood of Christ, inebriate me.
Water from the side of Christ, wash me.
Passion of Christ, strengthen me. O good Jesus, hear me. Within your wounds, hide me. Separated from you, let me never be. From the malignant enemy, please defend me. At the hour of my death, please, please call me. And close to you bid me, that with your saints I may be praising you forever and ever. Amen.*

This weekend, we are delighted to welcome back SPIRITUS Ministries, which has been a great blessing to our parish over the years. We especially look forward to their work with our Confirmation candidates during their Confirmation retreat this same weekend. As we celebrate their ministry, we are reminded of the power of faith and gratitude, a theme beautifully illustrated in the Gospel reading of the Ten Lepers from Luke 17:11-19.

In this story, Jesus heals ten lepers, but only one returns to give thanks. This one man, a Samaritan and an outsider, turns back, glorifies God, and falls at Jesus' feet in gratitude. Jesus observes the absence of the others and tells the thankful man, "Your faith has saved you." This encounter reveals a crucial spiritual lesson: while all ten received the gift of healing, only the one who returned with a grateful heart received the deeper gift of wholeness through faith.

Our Candidates will experience a similar encounter through SPIRITUS. The young missionaries of SPIRITUS dedicate themselves to sharing the joy of the Gospel and acting as vibrant witnesses to the power of a grateful faith. Through high-energy talks, dynamic activities, and heartfelt witness, they inspire our young people to personally encounter Christ and respond with a thankful heart, preparing them for their Confirmation Mass on October 26.
