

Do you pray before you go to sleep at night? Too tired to pray? Don't know what to say? I suggest these questions, because they are the same questions/reflections I had for years. Prayer is always a choice. One of the many great things about our faith is that we have prayers we don't need to create or make up; there are many prayers to help us as we retire for the day.

Parents wishing to initiate their children into the Catholic Christian faith through the waters of Baptism need to attend the Baptism Preparation Class.



This weekend, we are delighted to welcome back SPIRITUS Ministries, which has been a great blessing to our parish over the years. As we celebrate their ministry, we are reminded of the power of faith and gratitude, a theme beautifully illustrated in the Gospel reading of the Ten Lepers from Luke 17:11-19.




